



A. Nylon or Leather Collars

Measure the circumference of pet's neck and add 2".

$\frac{1}{2}$ "– $\frac{3}{8}$ " width is best for puppies and small dogs. $\frac{3}{8}$ "– $\frac{3}{4}$ " width is best for small to medium dogs. 1"– $1\frac{1}{4}$ " width is best for large dogs.

Collars

B. Prong Chain Training Collars

Measure around the dog's neck and add 1"–2". Prong Collars should fit snug and high on dog's neck. Millimeter (mm) size refers to the thickness of the wire. For a longer collar in the thickness that you prefer, add extra links.

C. Choke Chain Training Collars

Measure the circumference of pet's neck and add 2"–3". The effectiveness of the correction will be diminished if collar is too loose.
