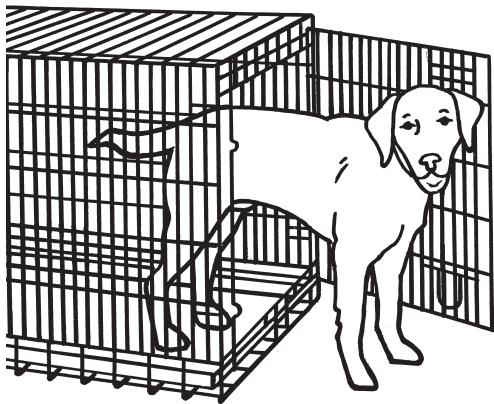


## Crates

Measure dog's height to the shoulders, and length from chest to base of tail, then add 4"– 6" to each measurement. See below for estimations by breed.



## Selecting a Crate Mat

Refer to the base dimensions of your crate or kennel. If dimensions do not match exactly, we recommend selecting a crate mat  $\frac{1}{2}$ "–1" smaller than base dimensions of your crate.

### **XS** (X-Small)

*Cat, Yorkshire Terrier,  
Chihuahua, Maltese,  
Italian Greyhound*

### **M** (Medium)

*Basset Hound, Bulldog,  
Keeshond, Norwegian  
Elkhound, Dalmatian*

### **L** (Large)

*Afghan, Doberman,  
German Shepherd,  
Irish Setter,  
Rottweiler, Collie*

### **S** (Small)

*Beagle, Boston Terrier,  
Cocker Spaniel, Pug*

### **ML** (Medium-Large)

*Boxer, Standard  
Poodle, Golden  
Retriever, Labrador*

### **XL** (X-Large)

*Great Dane, Great  
Pyrenees, Greyhound,  
Mastiff, Saint Bernard*

The sizes indicated above are recommended for travel. For household use, select a size or two larger. This will allow the dog ample room to stand, turn around and lie down. If your dog's breed is not listed above, compare the dog's body size to a similar-sized breed or follow measuring instructions.
